BECOME AN ALP MEMBER IN 2024

Accredited Lighting Practitioner (ALP) is an additional qualification for those members of IESSA who wish to maintain high standards in the future by undertakings in the lighting industry.

ACCREDITED LIGHTING PRACTITIONER CRITERIA

1. Shall have obtained an academic level of education equivalent to Grade 12 or N3 with Mathematics and Science AND have at least 10 years of relevant experience in the lighting industry.

OR

2. Shall have obtained a minimum of 3 years approved profession related tertiary education AND have at least 5 years of relevant experience in the lighting industry. (Electrical Technician / Electrical Engineer)

OR

3. Shall have completed the Diploma in Illumination Engineering AND have at least 5 years of relevant experience in the lighting industry.

(Diploma in Illumination Engineering → Completed Modules 1 – 5 of lighting courses presented by IESSA yearly. Four of the courses to be passed with Proficiency 70% and higher and the remainder course 50% to 69% pass mark).
